NORTHERN CRUISER stalked the leaders, raced four deep in the stretch and closed with a rush to just get up under steady handling. TOOL TRADE vied for the lead from the outside, made a clear lead into the upper stretch and was just caught near the wire in a game effort. PATRIATE was hustled from the inside and finished willingly to the wire. TIMETOBOOK dueled for the early lead and weakened a bit the final sixteenth of a mile. HAJA BOY was slow early, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. RED HOT FEVER showed little. TURBO ENERGY was outrun.
