### Footnotes

BUBBLE B. BUDDHA made the pace on a short lead racing about the three or four path, kicked clear through the far turn then angled further in the track and drew off under steady handling. BOOTDIM settled in good position racing four wide to stalk the leaders, moved nearest the winner into the far turn then could not match strides the remainder while holding clear for his position. ACTION CALL dropped off the early pace racing out from the rail, angled out in the far turn to rally four and five wide but could not get to the top pair in the lane. FOOLISH DEPUTY followed the pace from a close up position three wide and weakened in the far turn. BLUERIBBONBREW raced wide and was always back. SEA SALTY RUN prompted the pace from inside the winner to late backstretch and tired.
