CATTLE BARON was allowed to settle early, moved up six wide nearing the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear in the final stages under strong pressure. SUPER SCENE stalked the pace, raced five wide in the lane and finished second best. CONNIE'S MAN pressed the pace while racing between rivals and weakened in the final stages. SENOR SCAT showed good speed from the inside and tired. MAYOFWHICHYEAR raced in tight quarters early, was fanned eight wide in the stretch and never was a serious threat. SLEWJACK broke awkwardly, moved up seven wide in the stretch and never menaced. HEAD OF THE GAME raced four wide and never threatened. CARLISLES BILLYBOY stalked the pace from the inside, took up nearing the eighth pole and faded thereafter. WILDCAT ALLI K showed little. PAR'S LAST SPIRIT stalked the pace, moved to challenge through the turn, clipped heels and unseated his rider.
