SEA SALTY RUN was off slowly, moved up four wide and drove clear in the final stages. SAL PARADISE pressed the pace, raced well off the inside in the lane and finished second best. MONARCH'S SHUFFLE was off slowly, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and made a mild late gain. HE'S GOIN NORTH stalked the pace from the outside while racing four wide and weakened in the lane. VALID MYTH stalked the pace, raced towards the inside and had no rally. DIGITRY was bumped at the start, raced along the inside and tired. MATT N MITCH was slow early and never menaced. SPORTS MANIAC showed little.
