THE NUTZ brushed with a rival at the start, vied from outside SPLITSVILLE to midway of the backstretch, moved clear and took command through the far turn then was roused intermittently through the lane. MR. INTENSITY stalked the pace from three or four wide then could only follow the winner home through the stretch while moving clear for his position. SPORTS MANIAC was shuffled back between rivals at the start, saved ground and moved up through the lane while not a threat. TOGATAS stalked the leaders from outside and weakened. BRATSVILLE brushed with the winner at the start and failed to threaten racing three or four wide. GOLDEN SUNRISE was not a factor from along the inside. SPLITSVILLE showed early speed from inside the winner and dropped out through the far turn.
