Footnotes

BEVYS BEST broke sharply and moved clear into the first turn, made all the running racing out from the rail, shook off a bid late in the far turn to kick clear again and held sway under steady handling. JUSTABIT SHAWKLIT brushed with a rival at the start, moved up four wide to bid outside the winner through the far turn then could not match strides through the lane while holding position. COYANOSA was caught in tight quarters between rivals in the early going to get shuffled back, rallied three wide through the far turn into the lane with his bid but could not reach the top ones. HESO saved ground in good position but lacked a final closing response. BLUMIN ATTITUDE brushed with a rival at the start then saved ground while off the early pace, angled out in traffic and steadied off heels nearing the stretch then could not close late. SKWHIRL lacked early speed while racing outside, moved inside through the far turn and made a mild late run up the rail but could not threaten. SHOW MY DANCER was outside throughout and lacked a rally. DID broke into the side of the gate then rushed up to press the pace from outside the winner and tired through the far turn. TRACK HERO stalked the pace from four or five wide and tired. HIGH FLEET was a close up factor along the inside through the first turn but tired before going a half mile.
