SUNDAY DANCER settled back off the early pace racing outside, rallied through the far turn then closed willingly in the lane run down ARTA B TRICKY and prevail in the closing jumps. ARTA B TRICKY tracked the pace from outside to move three and four wide on the far turn, was packed out and bumped as MEXICAN TIME came out a bit then finished well but could not contain the winner. MISS G. I. showed the most early speed to vie on the lead from inside, edged clear into the lane and weakened late. HOLY MOLLY stalked the leaders from four wide but lacked a closing bid. MEXICAN TIME vied from outside MISS G. I. to late in the far turn, came out to bump with the place horse and weakened. C O ATTACK saved ground in reach of the leaders to the far turn and tired. LIL WHISKEY GIRL was always back. GHAZOLENA was not a factor. SCATZOPHRENIC dropped back steadily from along the inside.
