JETA'S LIL RED dueled from the three path while inside LOOKIN BETTER BABY, moved clear through midstretch then held safe late as MILLIE'S THUNDER made a late run. MILLIE'S THUNDER broke inward to bump with a rival, rallied three wide in the turn and continued with a good late run to be getting to the winner. NAVAJO WOMAN bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground and rallied through the lane. TIME TAMER tracked the leaders from four wide and lacked a final closing response. LOOKIN BETTER BABY dueled from outside the winner to upper stretch and weakened in the drive. I DO VOODOO ON YOU saved ground and lacked a rally. QUEEN OF THE HEAP weakened while four to five wide in the turn. THREADS OF SILVER angled in to save ground nearing the turn but failed to threaten. RINGATSEVEN saved ground and was outrun.
