DAKOTA SONG dueled for the early lead, raced three deep and prevailed in the drive under all out pressure. NOTHINGFEARED dueled for the lead along the inside and finished gamely to just miss. AMY CATHERINE dropped back early, moved up along the inside, was blocked from the sixteenth pole to the wire to be full of run late despite a troubling trip. MOR THAN THE REST was hustled along throughout and weakened a bit in the final stages. ILE ST. ROSIE stalked the leaders from the outside, raced five deep in the stretch and never was a factor. KIPAHULU failed to respond. STRATEGIC STAR was slow early, raced six wide into the upper stretch and never menaced. GONE BERTIE was slow early, moved up four wide and never threatened. FROSTY DEBUT failed to sustain a bid.
