SOME CHARMER stalkd the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to draw clear under strong handling. MOORE WEST set all the pace, raced just off the inside and finished second best. MISSTA H W raced a bit wide early, moved up five wide in the stretch and gained ground gamely in the latter stages. TRIPSTAR was allowed to settle early, saved ground and had no final winning bid. EVE N TOUCH stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. PRIMISTALLA was five deep in the stretch and never was a factor. THREE RIVERS showed little. ONEBADJOE failed to respond. OPIE OBOE was hustled along from the outside to press the pace and tired. CLASSIC MCCOOL failed to menace.
