THE NUTZ settled back off the pace racing four and five wide, launched his rally in late backstretch, fanned seven wide into the lane and closed with a determined run to wear down SONG OF HUMOR in the closing jumps. SONG OF HUMOR moved to a clear lead in the first turn racing about the three path, carried the lead into the lane then was allowed to drift in nearer the rail and could not keep the winner safe late. LOUIE TRE was five wide in the first turn while stalking the leaders, rallied wide into the lane and gained clear for third but could not menace the top pair. TRICKYEXPECTATIONS was five and six wide through the first turn, remained outside while stalking the leaders, came six wide into the lane and could not close late. REACH ONE MORE saved ground while in good position stalking the leaders, bid nearing the lane while angling three wide and could not sustain the effort. BUDDY GEORGE settled back off the pace racing out from the rail and failed to mount a rally. KID RAMBO chased the early pace racing out from the rail and weakened. WOODEN YA KNOW IT followed the pace racing three to four wide and tired. SO GONE was always back racing three wide.
