### Footnotes

MISTER FRIENDLY stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to get up under all out pressure. BLOOMIN AT DAWN set all the pace along the inside and finished second best. RUN SEVILLE RUN was bumped hard at the start, raced in tight quarters nearing the eighth pole and finished willingly in the final stages. SENATOR BERI popped the gate, ran off briefly, settled off the early pace, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and had no final winning bid. SNEAKIE PETESKI was unhurried early, raced four wide in the lane and had no late winning bid. QUICK KETCHUP raced six wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. LIMITED stalked the pace and weakened in the drive. OAK VALLEY was bumped at the start and remained back throughout. ZOOHA'S LAST BABY showed little. PEACH JUICE was hustled along and tired.
