TALBOT stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to get up under all out pressure. GRAND ON AFFAIR vied for the early lead, raced three wide in the lane and finished second best. BELOIT KAN TOO was hustled from the outside to press the pace and finished willingly to the wire. IT'S NO GIRL stalked the leaders, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and closed in on the latter stages. BELVER was hustled from the inside and weakened. GOATFEATHERS raced four wide and never was a factor. DANT failed to respond. KENTUCKY THUMBS UP saved ground and never menaced. JAYEMBRO was outrun. WALNUT TREE trailed throughout.
