MIDNIGHT AFFAIR forced the pace three and four wide outside HARDWICKE HALL, continued well in the lane to wear down that rival and prevailed late. HARDWICKE HALL was on the pace racing out from the rail while pressed by the winner throughout, dug in stubbornly to get back in front through midstretch then just failed to hold that one safe while saving second. MINTS N THE VALLEY saved ground to late backstretch, angled out to rally four and five wide in the far turn then continued with a good late run to narrowly miss. LIBBYS LITTLE HAWK settled back off the pace racing four and five wide, swung six wide into the lane and also closed well late. B G GOLDEN TIME saved ground in good position but failed to rally late. DISTANT KAIN stalked the pace racing four wide and weakened. LUCKY DAZ tired racing three wide.
