MISS TWO BAGGER was allowed to settle early, moved up between horses in the upper stretch while racing three deep, angled to the inside inside the sixteenth pole and got up under all out pressure. PASSEM ALL was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to just miss. DAISY DOUBLE stalked the pace, moved up four wide and finished gamely in the drive. IMA VALENTINE stalked the pace, raced three wide and faded. BLIND REALITY was slow early, moved up four and gained ground in the final stages. T CS ORBITING MISS was hustled along the inside to press the pace and faded. CAL BRITE failed to sustain a bid. CHARLIES COOK pressed the pace between horses and tired. DAWN RENEE showed little.
