**Footnotes**

LIGHT ON TOP was content to stalk the dueling leaders early while four and five wide, quickly moved to challenge midway up the backstretch and drew clear into the far turn then drew off in the lane under a strong hand ride. CENTER COURT STAR moved four wide in the far turn to take aim at the winner but could not match strides while holding clear for his position. EL INTOCHABLE was placed out from the rail to late backstretch, angled four and five wide in the far turn to move up through that bend but could not menace the top pair. MISSION ENVISIONED moved up three wide while not a threat. YANKEE STORM was always back. LORD OF TRICKS was not a factor racing three or four wide. STAG RUNNER contested the early lead racing out in the three to four path and tired. MACHUPECHI contested the lead from outside STAG RUNNER and tired.
