### Footnotes

KEYLESS settled off the dueling leaders racing three and four wide, moved up outside to bid and move clear in late backstretch, dug in when challenged through upper stretch and gamely held STREAKIN BEAUTY safe to the wire. STREAKIN BEAUTY broke inward and bumped with a rival, settled off the pace, rallied four and five wide through the far turn into the lane, ranged up outside the winner to reach near even terms then could not get by in the closing sixteenth. BRAHMS SONG saved ground to improve some position in the far turn then could not threaten in the lane. CAPRINA broke outward and bumped with a rival, dueled racing out from the rail and inside SWEET FATE then came up empty nearing the lane. DIANNA'S D. D. was not a factor. SWEET FATE was bumped between rivals at the break, quickly recovered to duel from outside CAPRINA through the opening half mile and tired.
