SPEEDY CORVETTE rallied to the front from four wide heading up the backstretch to take command through the far turn then drew off under steady urging in the lane. MY MAN BOOMER lunged at the break to get away awkwardly, tracked the pace from outside SPOOKY THUNDER, appeared to lug in and was steadied off that one's heels into the far turn, recovered to chased the winner into the stretch as clearly second best. TUTLES broke into the side of the gate and was away slowly, raced out from the rail to late backstretch then moved up through the far turn while no threat to the top pair. ROSS broke inward to bump with HARRYANDARTSGHAZI, saved ground to the far turn then angled out in the lane to improve position while no threat. HARRYANDARTSGHAZI broke into the side of the gate then bumped with ROSS, lugged in shortly after and appeared to hit the rail to drop far back then could not threaten. HUGH saved ground and tired. SPOOKY THUNDER contested the pace to the far turn racing out from the rail and shortened stride through the far turn.
