THE NUTZ settled back off the leaders racing outside in the first turn, moved nearer the inside heading up the backstretch then made a good move to contention in the far turn, came five wide into the and responded when set down to collar TIGER LAKE through the closing sixteenth and be quickly moving clear. TIGER LAKE was just off the early pace racing outside, moved four wide into the lane with his bid to move clear briefly in midstretch then could not withstand the winner's late run. WHAM was in good position just off the leaders racing out from the rail but offered no late run. BEVYS BEST showed in front and moved clear in the first turn, was taken out about the four path turning into the backstretch, continued on the pace to upper stretch and had nothing left. SKWHIRL saved ground and failed to produce a solid bid. MIKE'S PET saved ground and failed to rally. MOON ODYSSEY stumbled at the start but quickly recovered then failed to threaten racing four wide. ENTOURAGE was always back. PLAGIARIST stalked the leaders from outside and tired. BLUE COMIN THRU tired racing four and five wide.
