CINDEE stalked the pace, moved up four wide and finished gamely in the drive to get up under all out pressure. ORMONTE'S LADY stalked the pace, moved up along the inside and finished second best. LITTLE CENT was allowed to settle early, moved up along the inside and made a mild late rally. WIN FOR GLEN DEENA stalked the pace and weakened. MISS TWO BAGGER failed to menace. MISTY HAWAIIAN raced three wide and never threatened. FUZZY NAEVUS set all the pace and tired. WINTER LADY showed little. THE FIRST BULL was hard sent from the start and tired. ROVING LADY raced along the outside and never threatened.
