FLEXTHEGOLDENPIPES was on the pace racing about the three path, moved clear into the far turn and drew off in the lane under steady hand urging. OTIS HILL dropped back off the early pace racing outside, rallied five and six wide through the far turn into the lane and moved clear for the place while no threat to the winner. BEGG'S saved ground and could not close in the lane while holding position. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD was just off the early pace racing four to five wide, remained nearest the winner into the lane and weakened. CAPTAIN CUGAT lacked a bid racing four wide. LET ME DOWN EASY contested the early pace from along the inside and weakened. TOP OF THE HERD lunged at the break and was always outrun. SILVER WILDCAT was six wide through the first turn, remained outside and tired.
