WOO PIG SOOIE set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. A. K. A. BUBBA was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide in the stretch and gained ground in the final stages. KIPRUSOFF pressed the pace from the inside and finished willingly to the wire. GORDO AT WAR settled off the early pace, raced six wide into the upper stretch and made a good late bid. BOB THE BEAR stalked the pace while racing four wide and weakened in the drive. MINOR LEAGER stalked the pace from the outside and tired. SIR GHAZI saved ground and never threatened. MYWILDIRISHDREAM was slow early and never menaced. WERRABRAVECYCLONE raced six deep in the stretch and was always back. CHALLENGE RIVER raced far back and never menaced.
