NAFIR'S LAD set all the pace along the inside and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. FLASHY MIKE stalked the pace, moved up along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. WORKIN' THE CROWD was unhurried early, raced five wide at the eighth pole and closed in gamely in the final stages. POWER SWEEP LEFT stalked the pace, raced three wide and weakened. COLOR OUT was off a step slow, raced four wide and made a mild late bid. MINNESOTA SLEW saved ground and never was a factor. SCENIC SHADOW dropped back early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. MASTER SERGEANT failed to respond. SELECTED failed to sustain a bid. CASSANOVA KID was pulled up and had to be vanned off.
