BOB THE BEAR stalked the leaders racing three and four wide, rallied five wide into the lane to move clear and drew off under mild encouragement. BOZO stalked the leaders while three to four wide then could not go with the winner while gaining the place through deep stretch. TOP GUN TIME contested the pace racing out from the rail while inside FIVE MILE then weakened a bit in the lane. MR. SLY settled back off the pace racing three wide then moved up from five wide into the lane. I'M MOVIN ON saved ground and was not a threat. BUPE BUPE TEE DO stalked the leaders while saving ground, moved into contention going to the far turn but weakened. FIVE MILE pressed the pace from outside TOP GUN TIME for a half and weakened.
