COMIC'S PRINCESS stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to get up under strong encouragement. INDYS PROSPECTOR vied for the early lead along the inside and finished second best. PATRONESS KATHY pressed the pace from the outside, gained command into the upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid to the wire. TETON FIRE was bumped at the start, raced in tight quarters soon after the start, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly in the final stages. LADY PEACE was bumped at the start, raced three wide in the lane and had no final winning bid. SUE THE TIGER was bumped at the start, raced towards the inside and never was a factor. FIRE N SMOKE showed little. JACKS Y U was squeezed back at the start, hustled to contention from the inside and tired. PICCOLINNI was bumped at the start and never was a factor. GONANDUNIT raced far back, was pulled up and walked off the track.
