ALEGRA broke inward to bump with a rival, contested the lead outside BLUMIN BABY to kick well clear late in the turn then drew off under urging in the lane. FINAL WORD bumped with a rival at the start, rallied four wide in the turn and gained clear for the place but could not threaten the winner. TEQUILA PRINCESS bumped with a rival at the start and moved up three wide. BLUMIN BABY contested the early lead from inside the winner and weakened. CEDAR HILL MISS was shuffled back between rivals at the start, recovered to get near the early leaders then was climbing early in the turn to drift out and weakened. S D P HAPPY BOTTOM moved up six wide in the turn to best the others. BIG BAD BUNNY saved ground and tired. RINGATSEVEN bumped with a rival at the start and tired while four wide. SANTA FE PRINCESS was bumped at the start and always back.
