Footnotes

RIGGAN stalked the pace, raced in tight quarters at the nine sixteenths pole, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and drove clear in the final stages under all out pressure. ANOTHER BUMPER pressed the pace, moved up three wide in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. MIDVAIL set all the pace from the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. FORTY BELOW was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. COWBOY JOE angled to the inside down the backstretch to save ground and had no response. SPOKEN IN TONES was slow early and never menaced. TOOTS AND DAZZLES raced four wide at the eighth pole and never was a factor. SUMMER JONES saved ground and never menaced. SLY SPY showed little. MINIMAL RISK failed to sustain a bid.
