NORTHERN CRUISER stalked the leaders racing three to four wide, rallied to contention in the far turn then responded when set down to edge clear through the closing sixteenth. JUNGLE RAJ rushed up outside ABSOLUTELY LIT to quickly move clear in the first turn, continued on the pace to upper stretch then could not handle the winner while holding the place late. FIVE ALARM reared into the side of the gate to come away very poorly, rallied three and four wide to take aim at the leaders in the far turn then could not sustain the rally in the lane. SKWHIRL dropped back early racing three wide, moved up while angling through the lane but could not threaten. NOT SO WILD stalked the leaders racing four wide and weakened. ELUSIVE WAYS was four to six wide on the turns and weakened. ABSOLUTELY LIT showed the most early speed to cross over and gain the inside before reaching the first turn, was soon cleared by the runnerup then tired in the far turn. LAST TRIBUTE was outrun. PERI PERI tired racing outside.
