Footnotes

LEES DYNA MAN bumped with a rival at the break, stalked the pace in good position from four wide, moved five wide into the lane and rallied clear under steady handling. MINIMAL RISK followed the pace racing out from the rail, angled four wide into the lane then came back inside to bid between rivals through midstretch and gained the place in the closing jump. HICKOK prompted the pace from outside STORMONTHEMOVE to edge clear nearing the lane then came up empty in the final furlong to lose position. SCAB bumped with the winner at the break, saved ground while well off the pace, moved inside to and improved position through the far turn then could not threaten late. STORMONTHEMOVE set or forced the pace from along the inside to late in the far turn and weakened. IT'S A FALLACY stalked the pace racing three and four wide, moved five wide into the lane and lacked a final closing response. BAH SHERT broke inward but was quickly corrected, raced towards the back of the field while four and five wide and failed to threaten. INTRO TO was not a factor racing three wide. NORTHERN GOVERNOR drifted five wide outside the leaders in the first turn and tired.
