ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE tucked inside to save ground in good position, rallied up the rail as WYALAYA came out into the lane then closed determinedly and ran that one down to prevail in the closing jump. WYALAYA made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail, came out further to be four wide into the lane, held to deep stretch and just failed to last. HOLYCHOIR was taken outside rivals into the first turn, bid three wide in the far turn then could not produce the needed late run. FAST CITY GIRL settled back off the pace racing three wide and lacked a solid closing response. CLASSIC MAURA stalked the pace racing three to four wide, made a bid into the far turn and could not sustain the run. CO SASSY saved ground and failed to offer a bid. QUITE A KITTY broke into the side of the gate to come away slowly and failed to threaten racing four wide.
