NO PRESSURE tracked the early leader from three wide to bid heading up the backstretch, quickly moved clear then held sway late under steady urging. SIR GHAZI was five and six wide through the first turn while just off the pace, remained outside to rally four wide into the lane and slowly closed but could not run down the winner. WILLIANO was four and five wide in the first turn while near the pace, angled in nearing the lane and had no final run. CERVEZA FRIA dropped back early racing out from the rail, angled out to move up five wide into the lane but could not threaten. GRAMMAS BOY lacked a rally racing three wide. HUSTLIN BOBBY saved ground and failed to mount a bid. JUKE JOINT JOHNNY followed the pace from three wide and tired. LOSTINTHESEA showed early speed to gain the inside then gave way in the far turn. MARCH FOR THE GOLD was always back.
