SAMMY WILL TELL moved to a short lead soon after the break, continued from about the four path and held his margin through the lane under steady handling. MACHO CRAZY was just off the winner racing two to three wide and held his position through the lane while unable to close on the winner. BUBADAREDBOY lacked a final closing response while three wide. AFRIENDFORLUCY moved up four wide while not a serious threat. ADAIR COUNTY came away last then moved up while three wide through the turn. R KIM TIPPER lacked a rally from along the inside. K. BOY chased the leaders while four wide and weakened. ONE LAST YANKEE was five wide on the turn then failed to threaten while widest into the lane. CASH AFFAIR was not a threat racing two and three wide. RYAN'S WAY trailed throughout. The race was run during a heavy snowfall with limited visibility.
