Footnotes

TIDAL STORM made the pace on a short lead from the two to three path while pressed by BUBBLE B. BUDDHA, kicked clear nearing the lane then held safe under steady urging in the lane. BUBBLE B. BUDDHA lunged at the break, prompted the pace from outside the winner and slowly closed late but could not run that one down. SAINT CHOCOLATE settled back off the pace racing two to three wide, rallied into the lane and closed but was too late. WATCH THE GAP stalked the pace in good position from about three wide and lacked a final closing response. BLAKE RATTLENROLL was angled outside the leaders in the first turn to stalk while four to five wide and lacked a solid closing bid. GO WEST BERT saved ground and lacked a closing bid. RED ROCK BLUFF was four and five wide while in reach of the pace, fanned seven wide into the stretch and lacked a late rally. RECKLESS CAPOTE failed to offer a bid racing four wide. BLUMIN ATTITUDE was not a factor racing three to four wide.
