GOATFEATHERS broke awkwardly, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. STEVE'S BIG MOE was slow early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and gained ground gamely in the final stages. BELOIT KAN TOO sprinted clear while well in hand, shortened stride in the final stages to weaken the final eighth. WINTER SUMMIT was unhurried early, raced four wide in the lane and never menaced. JIX showed little. WATOMGO failed to sustain a bid. ROOT RIVER KID was outrun. TOOTS AND DAZZLES trailed throughout.
