MISSY CAN DO set a fast pace along the inside, dug in gamely in the upper stretch and prevailed in the drive under strong pressure. LOVESMEGOLD was quick to begin from the outside, raced a bit wide around the first turn, pressed Missy Can Do down the backstretch, raced four deep in the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. FLAMING NIGHT stalked the pace along the inside, moved up to challenge in the upper stretch but could not match strides with the top two. MAGIC TRUMP was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide around the far turn and flattened out in the drive. FOXY PRO stalked the pace and faded in the lane. BURNING MEMORIES raced evenly and had no rally. BRIGHT FLAME was always back. BRANDY DOLL was outrun.
