Footnotes

BUMPNSHOOT showed good early speed, raced well off the inside into the upper stretch, came in at the sixteenth pole causing Miss Casey Baker to take up and held gamely to the wire under all out pressure. MISS CASEY BAKER stalked the pace, raced along the inside, took up at the sixteenth pole and finished gamely to the wire. SANTA FE STAR pressed the pace from the outside and weakened a bit in the final stages. FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL was slow early, raced five wide nearing the eighth pole and gained ground gamely in the final stages. TEXAS CHARM was bumped at the start, raced seven deep in the stretch and never was a serious threat. SWEDES FEVER was hustled along between horses and tired. PRECISE NIGHT was bumped at the start, raced wide throughout and never menaced. THAT DARN GRAY CAT failed to menace.
