THE NUTZ stalked the leaders from four wide to midway up the backstretch, readily moved to the leaders into the far turn and moved clear through that bend then drew off under strong hand urging. FIRST CLASS BRASS settled back while saving ground, awaited room into the far turn, remained along the rail to bid into the lane and gamely gained the place while unable to menace the winner. SKWHIRL brushed with a rival at the start, trailed early, was wheeled to the outside heading up the backstretch, rallied five and six wide through the far turn to take aim turning for home then could not save position late. MR. TANGO stalked the pace from four wide, was bumped nearing the lane while about six wide then moved up in the lane but could not threaten. SEASIDE LINKS was just off the leaders early racing three to four wide, lacked room and edged out to bump with MR. TANGO in the far turn then regained position in the lane while not a threat. BLUMIN ATTITUDE stalked the pace from along the inside to bid into the far turn then weakened into the lane. TIMETOBOOK brushed with a rival at the start, chased the early pace from four wide, came out through the far turn and weakened. KID RAMBO broke into the side of the gate then rushed clear to make the early pace from along the inside and tired. TSAR TOPS DANCER showed brief speed while inside and tired.
