FIRE UP THE BELL stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to prevail under all out pressure. GIN STINGER was unhurried early, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to just miss. EWING TIGER was allowed to settle early, raced five deep in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. MR. PINSTRIPE settle off the early pace, saved ground throughout and made a mild late gain. HALO'S ROCKET duelled for the early lead and tired in the drive. MY SECRET STAR was allowed to settle early, raced three wide in the lane, was struck by rivals whip nearing the sixteenth pole and never was a serious threat. KON KRETE KID raced six wide and never threatened. MANOVAN failed to sustain a bid. DIPPI TRIPPI stalked the pace and tired. SUPER J R duelled for the early lead and stopped.
