Footnotes

BOOTDIM was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and drove clear in the final stages. MAKING DREAMS showed good speed from the inside but was no match for the winner in the drive. DEVIL DARE YA was unhurried early, moved up four wide and made a mild late rally. UNTOUCHABLE TIME was slow early, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and made a good late gain. GOING GRAY stalked the pace and tired. TOMTHETAXMAN was off slowly, raced along the inside and never threatened. SUPER SCENE saved ground and never threatened. CONNIE'S MAN was hustled along and tired. COUNT COUP failed to menace. FLYINGSOFREE showed little.
