TIP CAT quickly opened a clear lead racing about the three path, continued on a clear lead to the far turn, was challenged by FROM THE ASHES turning for home, shook off that rival then held late as NAFATH made his late run. NAFATH bobbed at the break then brushed with a rival shortly after, settled back well off the early pace racing three or four wide, rallied five wide into the lane and closed willingly but could not reach the winner. FROM THE ASHES stalked the pace from three wide, moved inside through the far turn then came back out to bid outside the winner into the stretch and reach even terms but could not sustain the effort. BUBBLE B. BUDDHA saved ground in good position but failed to offer a closing bid. JUDGE FUDGE was shuffled back at the start, saved ground and failed to mount a bid. NOT SO TIMELESS was not a factor racing outside. TIDAL STORM stalked the leaders racing two to three wide and tired. JAYEMBRO stalked the pace from outside and tired. COMEDY KID broke outward and brushed with the runner-up, chased the pace and dropped back steadily.
