### Footnotes

MISS SPEED DIAL settled outside to track the pace racing three wide, moved four wide to bid with MISSY CAN DO approaching the far turn then determinedly wore that one down through the lane to prevail late. MISSY CAN DO was forced nearly eight wide on the first turn as a rival drifted out into that bend, made a strong move four or five wide heading up the backstretch to move clear into the far turn, briefly bore out turning for home but was quickly corrected then dug in gamely to duel the winner to the wire and missed in a strong effort. BEVYS AFFAIR showed speed along the inside, settled back heading up the backstretch while never losing her good position, rallied back into the stretch and missed late in a good effort. HUSKER VALLEY stalked the pace along the inside to bid and have aim turning into the stretch from along the rail, finished willingly but came up short in the tight finish. CASSA'S AFFAIR hesitated and lunged at the start to come away last, moved up outside to rally five wide into the stretch but could not run down the top ones. DEAD DOG GORGEOUS tracked the pace racing three wide while never far back and weakened in the late going. MEGANS MOLLY saved ground through the first turn, angled out heading up the backstretch but failed to offer a convincing rally. SUNDAYBLUMMER drifted wide into the first turn and tired.
