TASTE OF BATTLE set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under steady handling. DOUG was off slowly, raced four wide while stalked the pace and finished willingly in the final stages. FAREWELL BROADWAY was unhurried early, raced four wide in the stretch and made a mild late gain. WINTER SUMMIT pressed the pace and weakened a bit in the drive. MISSION ENVISIONED was slow early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. SEASIDE LINKS saved ground and never menaced. PECKINPAH raced five wide at the eighth pole and never threatened. FIRST CLASS BRASS stalked the pace along the inside and faded.
