RACEY STACEY stalked the pace outside in good striking position, moved three wide to bid and move clear approaching the lane then moved off under steady handling. MISS TWO BAGGER settled outside, moved up four wide through the far turn to rally into the stretch and could not run down the winner. CLAIRVOYANT GIPSY stalked the pace racing out from the rail and could not produce the needed late effort. SAL'S GAL came outward shortly after the start to bump KIST ALL OVER, rushed up to duel outside QUICKASALARK and edge clear into the far turn then came up empty in the lane. STREET DREAMER moved up along the inside while not a serious threat. KIST ALL OVER was bumped shortly after the start as SAL'S GAL came out, tracked the pace racing three wide and tired. QUICKASALARK dueled on the pace inside SAL'S GAL to late backstretch and tired. FUZZY NAEVUS was wide throughout. SEXY HOOLIGAN was always back.
