TICK'S SHADOW was bumped at the start, moved up three wide in the turn then angled five wide into the lane and drew clear under steady handling. CHELOKETTE contested the lead outside B G BLUE STAR through the turn then could not go with the winner in the lane. B G BLUE STAR was bumped at the break, showed speed from along the inside to vie to upper stretch and weakened. LITTLE SHEBA moved up six wide into the lane but lacked a solid closing bid. LADY'S EDITION saved ground and lacked a final closing run. CLOSE CALL broke outward to bump with a rival, saved ground just off the leaders then steadied and altered course outward in traffic through midstretch. SCIPIANA was bumped at the start and lacked a rally racing four wide. FINER SHINER failed to threaten while three wide. CEDAR HILL MISS was bumped at the start then weakened while three wide.
