BLACK STILETTO'S pressed the pace, raced four wide and finished gamely to just get up under all out pressure. PATRONESS KATHY set all the pace, built a clear in into the upper stretch and was caught late in a game effort. RACHEL'S SPECIAL stalked the pace from the outside, raced four deep in the lane and finished willingly the wire. JACKS Y U was hustled from the inside and was no real threat. CASSIE WILL DO IT was slow early, raced seven wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. HALO'S TIDE saved ground and never menaced. JAZZY DIVA showed little. INDYS PROSPECTOR was slow early and never menaced. JETA'S LIL RED stalked the pace and tired. GONANDUNIT dropped back early, raced six wide into the upper stretch and never was in contention.
