Footnotes

PRINCESS OF HOLME settled outside off the early pace, moved four wide through the far turn to bid five wide into the lane, responded when set down and closed strongly to wear down UP 'N BLUMIN and edge clear late. UP 'N BLUMIN broke into the side of the gate, stalked the pace racing three and four wide to bid outside MISSY CAN DO into the far turn, resisted the winner through upper stretch but could not match strides in the late going. BURNING MEMORIES saved ground racing out from the rail, moved three wide through the far turn to improve position but could not threaten the top pair late. MAGIC TRUMP moved up three and four wide while not a serious threat. MISSY CAN DO was on the pace outside STEAL MY KISSES to duel to the far turn, continued with UP 'N BLUMIN to upper stretch and tired. STARLORD was caught in tight quarters in the early going then failed to rally racing three and four wide. STEAL MY KISSES dueled on the pace inside MISSY CAN DO while just out from the rail and tired through the far turn.
