DANDY TOO broke hard to the outside and settled back off the pace racing three wide, moved to the outside going to the far turn to rally five and six wide through that bend into the stretch then continued with a strong late run to quickly collar the leader and move off under steady handling. ARMY OFFICER dueled on the pace from inside THE BIG LOMBOWSKI through the opening half mile, kicked clear through the far turn then could not handle the winner's late run while remaining clear for his position. PROCERITY settled back off the pace racing outside, made a move to contention while four or five wide in the far turn then lacked the needed response through the lane. WINTER SUMMIT stumbled into the side of the gate to come away slowly then was hung five wide in the first turn, continued outside to move up through the far turn but could not reach the top ones in the lane. SPEEDY CORVETTE stalked the dueling leaders while saving ground and weakened. FOREVER MOON saved ground while trailing to the far turn then moved up after angling widest into the lane. SECO EXPRESS hesitated then hit the side of the gate to come away slowly and was always back. THE BIG LOMBOWSKI dueled from outside ARMY OFFICER for a half and tired. STORMS ROCK saved ground and tired.
