MUSIC TOPPER moved up outside rivals leaving the second turn as the field bunched, bid with MARIANAS heading up the backstretch to move clear in the far turn then drew off under urging before being put to a hand ride in the final sixteenth. MARIANAS stalked the leaders from outside to make his bid through the second turn, continued with the winner to the far turn and could not match strides. CATTLE BARON was just off the leaders from along the inside in the second turn when forced to await room and steadied, remained in good position to the far turn but had no late run. FORESTRY'S CAT was in reach of the leaders as the field bunched in the second turn and tired. COUNT COUP tired racing out from the rail. DR. DAZZLE lacked any early speed to drop far off the early pace and never reached contention. SATAN'S FAST RIDE moved to a clear lead in the first turn, continued to make the running through the second turn then gave way entering the backstretch.
