WORKIN' THE CROWD settled outside to follow the leaders four wide, boldly rallied five wide through the far turn to quickly open a clear lead then kept a safe margin under steady handling. STRIKE IT RITZ followed the pace racing two to three wide, rallied four wide in the far turn then brushed with a rival nearing the lane and moved clear for his position while no real threat to the winner. GOLD GUY rallied four and five wide to bid through the far turn, brushe3d with STRIKE IT RITZ while outside that one nearing the lane and was outfinished for position late. SEA SALTY RUN moved up four wide but could not threaten in the lane. READYROLL saved ground and was not a threat. ROYAL SEAL broke into the side of the gate and was slow into stride then made a late rally from five wide into the lane. KING TYMATT contested the pace from inside BURN CARD for a half and tired. STRICTLY GOLD was not a threat. BURN CARD contested the pace from three wide and tired. MASTER'S HAND chased the early pace while saving ground and tired.
