METROPOLITAN MAN stalked the early pace, moved up four wide nearing the quarter pole to challenge, led into the upper stretch and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. BARRAMOON was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. SAINT CHOCOLATE settled off the early pace, raced six wide into the upper stretch and showed good late interest. GEOCACHE was slow early, moved up four wide through the far turn into the lane and closed belatedly. TIDAL STORM pressed the pace along the inside and tired. SCHWARTZBEWITHYOU saved ground throughout and never threatened. BRAZOS EGO vied for the lead while racing between horses and faded. BLESSED DAY was hustled along and tired.
